- Volunteers are expected to maintain guest confidentiality, including maintaining guest confidentiality to law enforcement unless proper authorization is provided (search warrant or approval from NOTS director). - Volunteers are expected to maintain a sense of professionalism and adhere to NOTS policies and procedures
- Volunteers are not to transport guests without prior authorization from the NOTS director
- Volunteers are not to take guests to a location outside of the NOTS center without prior authorization from the NOTS director
- Volunteers will maintain sobriety from drugs and alcohol while on shift
- Volunteers are not to provide guests with drugs or alcohol
- Volunteers are not to serve shifts while sick or under medical quarantine
- Volunteers who fail to show for one shift without prior notice will be placed on probationary status
- Volunteers who fail to show for two or more shifts without prior notice may be removed from active volunteer status
